1. Who are we?

2. General information about cookies

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer by the websites you visit. They contain session data related to your use of a website, which can be used by the website concerned for various purposes, such as to make your website visit more efficient or to measure activity on the website.

We make a distinction between essential cookies and non-essential cookies as follows:

Essential cookies are cookies that we need for the proper operation of our website. Essential cookies may for example save your language preferences through our different webpages, or allow you to complete a communication form and send your request or remark to us.

For the use of **non-essential cookies**, we will ask your permission to activate them, by means of our Cookie Banner that will pop-up when you first visit our website. You may withdraw your consent to the use of such cookies for the future, by changing your cookie preferences in the footer at all times.

We may update this cookie statement from time to time. If the changes impact cookies for which you have already provided your consent, or if we add additional cookies, you will be redirected through our cookie banner.
